

Rainbow Saddle Club Leisure Riding Program (RSCLR)

This will be similar to other horseback riding programs in that one must be a member of the Rainbow Saddle Club and pay a small enrollment fee. Riders will log the number of hours spent riding their horse(s) in non-competitive ways. This will include trail rides, lessons, parades or training. Competitive activities such as horseshows, fairs and competitive endurance riding are not eligible hours.

At the end of the year awards will be given to the riders who have logged the most hours. Lifetime Tier awards will also be given.

Purpose:

The purpose of RSCLR is to reward and recognize RSC members who do not show their horses but are active members of the club.

Enrollment:

In order to participate in RSCLR, you must be a member of RSC and pay a \$10.00 enrollment fee. You can ride more than one horse under this enrollment.

Hours:

Once a member has enrolled in the program they will be sent the log sheet(s) from the program coordinator. Participants are required to log their hours as well as the location. A separate log sheet is required for each horse.

Awards:

The 2011 season will run from May 3 to October 31, 2011. Participants will have until November 5 to get their log sheets to the program coordinator for the hours to be counted for that year. Awards will be given for the riders who logged the most hours.

Lifetime Tier awards have also been established. Once a rider reaches 50, 75, 100, 250, 500, 750, and 1000 hours they will receive a special award.

Only hours accumulated in consecutive years as an enrolled member will count towards these awards. If you choose not to participate for a year, all past hours are lost; you will start over from 0 with the next enrollment.

As with the other award programs RSC offers, to be eligible you must hold an Active Membership and fulfill the minimum 10 work hour requirement.
